Prior to Travel

VACCINES: Ugandan authorities require yellow fever certificate for all passengers entering the country. The cartificate can be issued by your health-care provides.

VISA: Nationals from the following countries do not require a visa. Members of COMESA (i.e. Burundi, Comoros, Kenya, Maumius, Sevonelles, Tanzania, Zimbabwe), The Bahamas, Jamaica, Sierra Leone.

For all other participants, PGA will soon transmit to you the letter issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Upanda to allow you to travel and obtain the visa upon arrival in Upanda In case there is e Upandan Embassy or Consulate in your country, you may use the same visa-letter and the PGA invitation letter to obtain a visa before your departure. The visa at the Consulate and at the Airport should be gratis. In case you are asked to pay, please keep the receipt of payment, PGA will refund it to you

If you will obtain your visa upon arrival in Kampala, you will be requested 2 passport photos
